Subject: The Polish 'Constitutional Tribunal' ruling on abortion

Dear President,
Dear Prime Minister,
Dear Marshals,

As Members of the European Parliament we are writing to express our serious concern about the recent roll-back on reproductive health and rights in Poland<sup>1</sup>. These further restrictions on access to abortion are a violation of Poland's international human rights obligations to guarantee women's fundamental rights. We condemn any use of force against peaceful protestors and incitement to violence against them, as well as attempts of intimidation against protest organisers by the National Public Prosecutor's Office. It is our firm belief that these developments are a clear manifestation of the ongoing deterioration of the rule of law and fundamental human rights in Poland.

Concerns over the independence and legitimacy of the Polish 'Constitutional Tribunal' have been repeatedly raised by the European Parliament, most recently in its resolution of 16 September 2020 on the determination of a clear risk of a serious breach by the Republic of Poland of the rule of law<sup>2</sup>, as well as by the European Commission and the Venice Commission. In light of its unlawful composition and functioning, the 'Constitutional Tribunal' can no longer be considered a legitimate body free from political interference.

Additionally, we stress that freedom of assembly is at the core of the European Union, including in times of a pandemic. Any restriction on that right must apply the principle of proportionality. We condemn the use of physical force and tear gas against the protestors, which feeds into the growing problem of police brutality in Poland. We also note with

concern the recent ordinance allowing the use of gendarmerie in law enforcement and stress that any response made by this force must respect the freedom of expression and of assembly.

In light of these grave concerns, we urge you to engage in a dialogue, to listen to the demands of the protestors, and to prevent any further escalation. We call on you to abstain from any new restrictions on fundamental human rights and ask you to put a stop to the dismantling of the rule of law in Poland.
